Cover Your Nose and Mouth When You Sneeze or Cough

Sneeze or cough into a tissue and then throw it away. Use your arm or sleeve if you do not have a tissue. After sneezing, coughing or blowing your nose, wash your hands immediately or use Stereze Hand Sanitizer to avoid spreading germs to others.



Wash Your Hands Frequently

Wash your hands with soap and water. Rub them together front and back for 20 seconds. Or use Stereze™ Hand Sanitizers if soap and water aren't available. Cover you hands thoroughly with the sanitizer and rub them together until they feel dry. Do not wipe or rinse sanitizer off.



Wipe Shared Surfaces and Equipment Regularly

Use Stereze™ alcohol-based wipes on commonly touched items such as doorknobs, faucet handles, copiers, coffee machines, desktops, handrails, phones, keyboards and elevator buttons.



Don't Touch Your Mouth, Nose or Eyes

Germs enter your body through those points. Apply Stereze™ Hand Sanitizers throughout the day, especially before eating and after using the restroom.
